### "Mustangs at the Mickyard" MCA Grand National Show to be held

There will be an MCA Grand National Show to be held in Orlando in the fall of 2013. "I think this is likely the

closest a Grand National will ever come to South Florida," said FLMC President, Mark Patterson.

The show is slated to be scheduled for the 2013 Labor Day Weekend. There will be lodging available for this event at the Coronado Springs Resort The resort reportedly set aside a block of 500 rooms with a discounted rate of \$99/night. The rate is good from August 26, 2013 thru September 5, 2013. Reservations will be accepted, for this event, beginning April 17, 2012 (a pertinent date, April 17, in the history of our beloved Mustang). The discount code is G0605618. ### *Bruce Solov: 2004 Ford Mustang Convertible*

Solov's 2004 Convertible

This month's Member's Car Spotlight is Bruce Solov's 2004 Convertible. Bruce has been a member since March 2011, but has had a love for the Ford Mustang and convertibles since his childhood. Being raised in Northern New Jersey, the climate was such that a convertibles and rear wheel drive cars were simply not practical.

"I have always had a hankering to have a both a Mustang and a convertible," he said. Prior to acquiring this car, he was driving a 2005 Toyota Corolla XRS. That all changed on the morning of December 16, 2010. Here is the story.

Solov was on the way to pick up his daughter in Pompano Beach. While stopped at a traffic light, his car was hit from behind by a Lexus (also stopped) behind him, which was hit by a cube van type truck. Fortunately neither he nor any of the others involved were injured.

It was a typical accident scene: police, fire-rescue, witness accounts, people on their cell phones outside their cars, etc. What happened in the aftermath was far from typical. Solov knew that several thousand dollars of damage was done, but had no idea that he would be told by his insurance company, that his car was a total loss.

"At that point, I decided I was going to find the number one car on my list of dream cars," he said. Thus, Solov was unexpectedly thrust into the market for a car. After searching for over a week, he found his "dream car" online, and was at a local dealership. He was sold just on the test drive, but only for the right price. The right price was reached, and the 2004 Convertible was his, completely paid for by insurance money. Needless to say, he will always own a Mustang convertible, and he has his sights set on getting the 50th Anniversary model in 2014, while still holding on to the car that "opened a lot of doors" for him.

In 1969, The Ford Mustang 'E', which was their economical version of the Mustang, debuted. This car featured a six-cylinder engine, coupled with a "highway axle ratio" and an automatic transmission. Only 96 of these were built, and only came as fastbacks.\*\*
