Fred Zaleski is the proud owner of this 1973 302 V8. He took delivery on June 6, 1973 from Friendly Ford in North Miami Beach FL. Fred's "73 Dream" is equipped with a 3-speed on the floor, factory air, Philco radio, factory deluxe interior, décor group, original mag wheels, Ford gages, tach, and racing mirror. He proudly states "Everything still works!" Truly amazing is the fact that the Mustang still cruises at 100+ mph all day long and still doesn't burn a drop of oil, despite the odometer reading 104,000 miles. In all these 37 years, the Mustang's heads were never touched; it never broke down, or even had a flat tire.

In 2001 Fred's "73 Dream" was displayed in "Memory Lane" at the Miami International Auto Show. Additionally, she placed "First in Class" at the all the entered Ft Lauderdale Mustang Club Round-Ups. Fred reports that he and his wife dated in the Mustang before they were married in 1975 – what great memories!

Recently, at a stop light, the driver of a 2003 Mustang did a "Linda Blair" 180-degree head turn looking at Fred's Dream, then he proceeded to give Fred a "thumbs up." He experienced a similar response when he passed a Camaro on I-95. But he won't tell us how fast he was driving.

Remarkably, Fred still has all the original documentation, factory and dealer invoices, owner registrations, manual with salesman's card, a 1973 Mustang dealer brochure, the lost key tag, and all Ford factory service manuals. On March 6, 2010 she placed second at the AACA National Meet at Homestead Speedway. Next year she will have the correct tires they require. Fred heard of the FLMC from his mechanic, Roddy, who put him in touch with Ted Parkhurst many years ago.

Fred fell in love with his Mustang the minute he saw her in a Ford sales brochure. And, like any great love affair, he states that he is more in love with her today.
