




Clewiston Sugar Festival

WHEELS HUBS AND LUGS TEC.

In my imaginary world I see the design team at an auto manufacturing facility finalizing the styling of the company's next production model. The project manager goes to another team of high paid , well educated wheel experts and assigns them the task of designing a wheel that compliments the new car. In my estimation they usually do a very good job to their credit.



No better example of this imaginary picture is early mustang's styled steel wheel and AKA rally wheel on 1964-67. In my opinion there has never been a more complimentary wheel mounted to these early mustangs. Many after market wheels have been placed on these cars, all of which scream "Imposter"!

The thing that escapes me is why on earth did these design experts make the rally wheel "Lug Centric"? In case you are not familiar with that term let me explain. I have learned it the hard way.

If you have ever mounted a wheel to the hub you may have noticed that in the great majority of cases the wheel's center hole fits closely over the hub. These wheels are known in the trade as "Hub Centric". They can be balanced off the vehicle on a balancing machine, slipped over the centering hub, secured with the lug nuts and rotate smoothly down the road.

This simplicity does not relate to a "Lug Centric" wheel. These diabolically engineered contrivances have a center hole that is much larger than the hub diameter and therefore depend upon the five mounting studs for centering. Thus the name "Lug Centric".

This insane design requires balancing with the wheel mounted on the car and spinning with a machine designed for such. Jim Smith directed me to the one shop in our area that can do this and it doubles the price of balancing.

I have tried the conventional off vehicle balance with my rally wheels. The resulting highway shake and bounce was more than I want to live with. Even the top of the radio antenna mast was whipping around in circles! Despite this inconvenience I still want their design on my car.

It evokes a barf when I see that the car owner has removed the wheels designed by experts then pays a small fortune for a set of over sized chrome monsters that look like a Roman Chariot reject.

450 Old San Carlos Blvd. Fort Myers Beach, Florida 33931

Take Alligator Alley to Exit 116, Bonita Springs

Go East on Bonita Beach Road, toward the Gulf Beaches. There will be a dog racing track on your left. You will cross over old US 41, then also cross over S. Tamiami Trail. Keep going toward the beaches.

When you get to the shore line, the street goes north and turns into Hickory Blvd, which becomes Estero Boulevard. Take Estero Boulevard north through Big Hickory Island, over New Pass, towards Lovers Key. You will cross over Little Carlos Pass and Big Carlos Pass. (and a bunch of other passes)

As you get into Fort Myers Beach, you will see The Lani Kai resort on the beach side (1400 Estero Blvd), a restaurant on the right called The Beached Whale (1249 Estero Blvd). You will make a right onto Crescent Street, between the Waffle house (1167 Estero Blvd) and the McDonalds (1153 Estero Blvd). Follow Crescent Street to the end, where it becomes 1st street. Make a left on Old San Carlos Blvd. Hotel on the left.
