My Mustang

The Phoenix Project:

Not the Arizona Capital. I compare the 10 year restoration of my 66 Mustang to the mythological bird that rose from the ashes fully restored and ready to fly. The 60's were a time of financial down turn at our house. When Ford introduced the Mustang in 1964, I was hooked. But I was also flying for a non-sched freight only airline in Detroit Michigan. We flew and were paid only when the company garnered a plane load of freight to be delivered. We actually had some deliveries from the Ford Factory. I recall a flight to Mexico City with a max load of Ford rear axle assemblies on a DC 6.* Meeting the mortgage on our home was a challenge. Car payments were out of the question. But my desire for a new Mustang never abated.

By 1966 I was flying for a major commercial airline in Miami, things were looking up. But we still had to play financial catch up. Come the 70's, two children in college, more financial load. My dear wife knew my heart's desire and suggested a used Mustang. Yes, why not, especially when in 1976 she found one in the classified. A 1966 Mustang convertible for \$200.00....Now that I can swing! The Mustang craze as we now know it now was not generally known at that time. At its south Miami location, I found it under a large tree. Top rotted off. Rain and weather had ruined the interior. Tree leaves covered what remained. Some previous owner had brush painted it with what looked like "Pond Scum Green". I made a 360 walk around and headed back to my car, regretting my long drive. The owner called out "Hey mister the tires alone are worth \$200.00". They were not but it was enough to turn me around for a closer assessment. This time I noted that it was what a body man would call a "Strait Car". No indication of collision damage. Also all original pieces were there and in place. Its possibility and my estimated capability solidified.

We had to tow it home. The 289 engine would run, but the transmission was useless. The brakes were also near non-existent. Even the parking brake cables had been intentionally severed so that some previous owner could couple them to a boat trailer. He could thereby apply the trailer brake handle. Real swift? This Pony had really been ridden hard and put away wet.

The next ten years of restoration, learning and surprises is a subject for another news letter report. By 1986 I considered it to be show worthy. Its before and after is why I called it the Phoenix Project. I joined the Ft. Lauderdale Mustang Club in 1987. At local shows it was usually a 2nd place winner. I painted it myself in my single car garage for less than \$100.00 worth of paint. It could not compete with cars that had \$3,000.00 and up professional paint jobs.

For the past 10 years I display only. It's gratifying to be recognized but I do not want anymore trophies. They soon become a storage problem. As I reported in my previous article it was a fun project at the time. To think of it now is enough to make me tired.
